1. There's a lot to be said about a person's credentials.
2. What could be said about Jesus? From the time that Jesus had arrived on this earth and began His public ministry until the time of the early apostles, until today, and until the very end of time, there is one simple message--the message that Christ is the Savior of the world.
3. Our passage is part of Peter's sermon on Pentecost.
4. Peter calls on several witnesses to confirm Jesus' identity. From Peter's sermon, we will examine several confirmations of God's witness.

I. Jesus Was Attested By The Works Of God (v.22).

- A God worked these miracles through Jesus.
- B The Jews witnessed Jesus' miracles.
- C We can witness the power of Jesus today.

II. Jesus Was Delivered Up By The Plan Of God (v.23).

- A God's plan required Jesus to die.
- B God used sinful men to accomplish His plan.

III. Jesus Was Raised By The Power Of God (vv.24-32).

- A Death could not hold Jesus (v.24).
- B King David prophesied of Jesus' resurrection (vv.25-32).

IV. Jesus Was Exalted To The Right Hand Of God (vv.33a, 34-36).

- A Jesus returned to His exalted position (v.33a).
- B God has made this Jesus both Lord and Christ (v.36).

V. Jesus Has Given Us The Spirit Of God (vv.33b-39).

- A On Pentecost the Holy Spirit was sent by the Father (v.33b).
- B Salvation is found in Jesus Christ (vv.37-39).
