1. If you could go back in time and approach Jesus, what would you ask Him?
2. I am going to read from **Matthew 19:16-26**.
3. There are three things about ourselves that we don't think that we are.
  - a. First of all, we never consider ourselves rich.
  - b. Secondly, we seldom think of ourselves as being young.
  - c. Number three, we have very little authority.
4. In this familiar story you might find some things about this man that actually apply to your life.
  - I. This Young Man Comes To Jesus With This Question.**
    - A. Why did he come to Jesus?
      1. Let me suggest 3 reasons why he came.
    - B. Here was a ruler running to Jesus to ask the most important question in life, "What good thing must I do to get eternal life?"
    - C. The Bible makes it clear that we never measure up.
      1. **Isaiah 53:6; Romans 3:23; Jeremiah 13:23.**
    - D. This is a repeated question.
      1. **Ecclesiastes 3:11 says "He has put eternity in their heartsB"**
  - II. What Did Jesus Tell Him To Do?**
    - A. Jesus answered him by saying, "**If you want to enter life, obey the commandments.**"
    - B. Notice a couple of things about what Jesus told him.
  - III. What Did The Young Man Do?**
    - A. This is one of the most touching scenes in the Bible.
    - B. Luke says he was extremely sad because he had great wealth.
  - IV. The Camel And The Eye Of A Needle.**
    - A. Some Bible commentators have had difficulty with this.
    - B. So the obvious question is, "Who then can be saved?"
