1. Today, as Christians, we have gathered to celebrate the resurrection of our Savior and Lord, just like every Sunday.
2. **1 Corinthians 15** is the great resurrection chapter of the Bible.
3. Paul presents a tremendous testimony to the resurrection of Jesus. Then he turns his attention to us.

I. The Promise of the Empty Cross.

- A. Because the cross was empty, we have the promise of forgiven sins.
- B. The promise of the empty cross is that you and I stand forgiven.

II. The Promise of the Empty Tomb.

- A. After pausing briefly to view the cross, the women continue on their way down the path to the tomb.
- B. The fact of the empty tomb is the truth of the resurrection of Jesus Christ and the promise to every one of us that we too will be raised to eternal life.

III. The Promise of the Empty Burial Clothes.

- A. After the Angel had spoken to the women, they immediately went back to the Apostles and reported what had happened.
- B. The promise of the empty burial clothes is that Jesus is alive, and wants to fellowship with you.
