1. Many parents spend significant time trying to decide what to name their children.
2. This morning we're going to zero in on four names given to Jesus.
3. Turn in your Bibles to **Isaiah 9:6-7**: **“For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Of the increase of his government and peace there will be no end. He will reign on David’s throne and over his kingdom, establishing and upholding it with justice and righteousness from that time on and forever. The zeal of the LORD Almighty will accomplish this.”**

**I. Jesus is Penetrating + He is “Wonderful Counselor.”**

- A. This title literally means “a wonder of a counselor.”
- B. Do we really see Jesus as a wonderful counselor?
  1. **James 1:5**
- C. What are some elements that make someone a good counselor?

**II. Jesus is Powerful + He is “Mighty God.”**

- A. This adjective means “strong one” or the “powerful warrior.”
  1. **John 10:30-33**
- B. The key thing to the divinity of Christ is that he has all the power of God.
  1. **Matthew 28:18; Ephesians 1:20-21**

**III. Jesus is Personal + He is “Everlasting Father.”**

- A. Have you ever thought of God being far off in the distance?
- B. What does it matter to us, what difference does it make?
  1. **John 14:6**

**IV. Jesus is Peaceful + He is the “Prince of Peace.”**

- A. The title, "prince of peace," is one of the most loved titles by which Jesus is known.
  1. **Luke 2:14**
- B. Did Jesus come to bring peace between people?
  1. **Romans 12:16, 18**
- C. Did Jesus come to give us a trouble-free life?
  1. **1 Peter 4:12**
- D. Jesus came to bring peace between God and mankind.
  1. **John 14:27**
